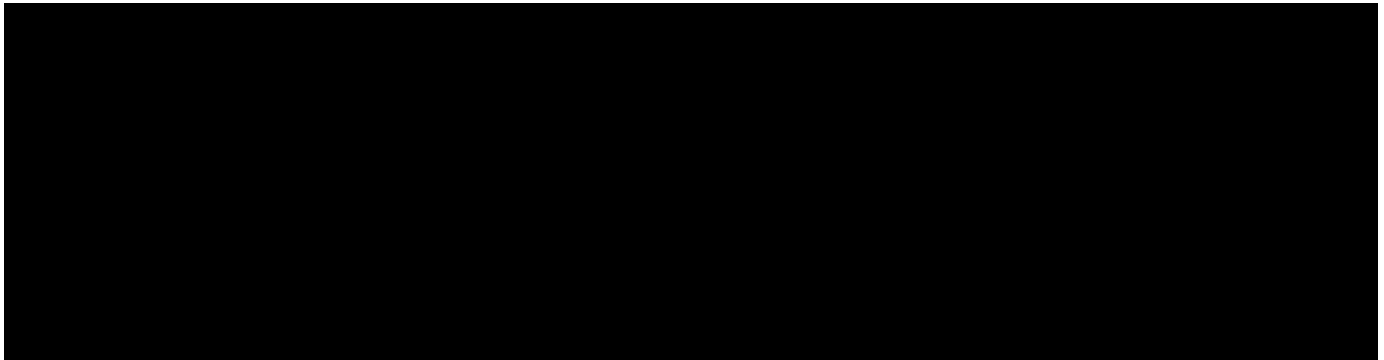

Get inspired by playing our Change Maker game and discover some top tips for fighting climate change and biodiversity loss.

CHANGE MAKER game instructions:

1. Tear off this section to leave a square piece of paper. Turn over the square so the yellow side is facing you.
2. Fold the square in half to make a rectangle. Open it up and fold again using the opposite sides.
3. Then fold the square in half to make a triangle. Open it up and fold again using the opposite corners.
4. Open it up and, with the yellow side facing you, fold each of the corners into the centre so that the coloured points meet.
5. Turn the paper over and fold each of the corners into the centre again.
6. Tuck your thumbs and forefingers in the four openings on the reverse to start playing.
7. Ask a friend to pick a colour. Move the game in and out for however many letters are in their chosen colour.
8. Ask them to pick one of the options revealed and again move the game to spell out the word.
9. Ask them to select another option from the choices shown; lift the flap to reveal inspiring ideas for how you can make a change.
