

Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007

Publication of the outcome of the Cornwall Community Governance Review held between February 2019 and January 2023

Meetings were held on 6th September 2022, 1st November 2022 and 12th January 2023 by the Constitution and Governance Committee to consider recommendations in relation to the outstanding items of the review that were deferred at a Council meeting held on 3 November 2020 in relation to the reassignment of key staff to support the pandemic response. The recommendations from these meetings were raised and discussed at an Extraordinary meeting of the Council held on 31st January.

The Council resolved that no change should be made to the following parish boundaries:

- a) The boundary between Newquay Parish and Colan Parish at Quintrell Downs;
- b) The proposed formation of a new Parish of Trevone is not accepted and there is no change to the boundary of Padstow Parish;
- c) The boundary between Madron Parish and Penzance Parish;
- d) The merger of St Minver Lowlands Parish and St Minver Highlands Parish does not proceed;
- e) The boundaries between St Minver Highlands and Lowlands Parishes;
- f) The Cubert and Perranzabuloe parish boundaries;
- g) The Helston and Wendron parish boundaries;
- h) The Newquay and Colan parish boundaries;
- i) The St Austell and Treverbyn parish boundaries;
- j) The St Austell and Pentewan Valley parish boundaries;
- k) The Stithians and Ponsanooth parish boundaries;
- l) The Truro and Kenwyn parish boundaries;
- m) The Wadebridge and St Breock parish boundaries;
- n) The boundaries within Penzance parish;
