## HAD289 PRELIMINARY CONSULATION ON PROPOSED REVISIONS TO FOOTPATHS 37, 42, 43 & 71

- 1 Thanks to Duncan for providing copies of the paperwork
- 2 Having reviewed the detailed proposals, the Group concluded:
  - That most extinguished footpaths had been replaced by an adjacent footpath more inland from the cliff edge which the group thought was a sensible approach for the future of the footpaths concerned
  - One exception where existing paths were duplicated (between points AA and AC); the cliffedge path was extinguished leaving the one more inland. This was considered acceptable.
- The group welcomed the confirmed route parallel with the cliff from Points S to P. The group appreciated the sensitivities around the existing footpath S to T but felt they would not be able to oppose its extinction since alternative routes to the road had been provided close by (V to U and P to Q)
- 4 Two points of concern were noted where leaving existing paths unchanged could be affected in the near future by future erosion:
  - Between Points N and O
  - Between Points AB and AC
